1	Company is hereby advised to submit Industrial Development Bureau (IDB) Registration Certificate to the Industrial Clients within Industrial Sector in Abu Dhabi Emirate as a part of selection / pre-qualification process.
2	This registration is not a substitute to any of the existing legal requirements applicable to the company by concerned Government Department(s) / Agency(s) responsible for qualifying company's personnel or providing authorization to the company to undertake the appropriate inspection and testing services within Abu Dhabi Emirate (e.g. DoE Commercial License, ADCCI Membership Certificate, Certificates from EAD, FANR, ESMA, MoL, etc.).
3	Industrial Development Bureau (IDB) Registration Process doesn't cover any verification of testing capabilities (equipment, machinery, method etc.), visit to company's premises and the skills of the personnel involved in the inspections and testing process.
4	Company is hereby advised to thoroughly assess the hazards and risks associated with the test and inspection activities and ensure protection of workers, environment and assets including compliance to clients' workplace HSE regulations.
5	Company is required to report all incidents immediately (within 24 hours) to Industrial Development Bureau (IDB) EHS Division involving personnel, machinery, equipment, assets, occurred while executing inspection and testing services within Industrial Sector in Abu Dhabi Emirate.  Failure to report incidents will result in the cancellation of this registration.
6	Company is required to submit Quarterly Performance Reporting (QPR) to Industrial Development Bureau (IDB) EHS Division including No. of Incidents occurred during the reporting period and action taken to avoid recurrence. QPR shall also include evaluation from the industrial clients regarding the quality of services provided by the company during the reporting period.  Failure to submit QPR will result in the cancellation of this registration.
7	Maintenance of this registration can only be achieved through the regularly and timely renewal of the applicable and relevant licenses and Personnel Qualifications Certificates (DoE Commercial License, ADCCI Membership Certificate, Certificates from EAD, FANR, ESMA, MoL etc.). Copies of such licenses and certificates shall be forwarded to the Industrial Sector EHS Regulator Authority on an annual basis either upon renewal of Industrial Development Bureau (IDB) Registration or included as a part of the Quarterly Performance Reporting.  Failure to maintain up to date records with Industrial Development Bureau (IDB) will result in the expiry of this registration.
8	Any changes to the company's status (contacts, office location, services, techniques, methods etc.) shall be notified immediately to the Industrial Sector EHS Regulator Authority.
